NINTH ASSEMBLY, UNITING CHURCH IN AUSTRALIA
Resolution 00.20.03

- 00.20.03 The Assembly resolved to:
- a. express its commitment to solidarity with all people seeking justice for war crimes;
 - b. express its belief that neither the passage of time nor the vagaries of location should become pretexts for inaction in the pursuit of justice;
 - c. work for the further development and acceptance of international agreements and efforts in bringing to justice alleged war criminals and persons charged with genocide;
 - d. encourage the Australian Government to
 - cooperate further with relevant bodies within Australia and overseas in the pursuit of alleged war criminals and those charged with genocide;
 - ensure that there are government or other officially recognised/authorised bodies in Australia with specific responsibility for the investigation and pursuit of alleged war criminals and those charged with genocide;
 - adequately resource appropriate government or other officially recognized/authorised bodies to investigate and act upon all allegations of war crimes and genocide brought against persons known or thought to be residing in Australia;
 - e. inform the Australian Government of these resolutions.
